

BULLETIN 21/04/2023

This bulletin covers the last four weeks of incidents since 23rd March 2023. The last four weeks have seen a slight increase in incidents across the country. Please take the appropriate measures to protect machinery, material and fuel tanks at your construction site.

FUEL THEFT

Fuel thefts continue to be an issue across the country and there has not been a specific trend in a particular area. If you have sites it this area, ensure your fuel tanks and machines are adequately protected.

Below are a note of the incidents and where they happened along with their crime report number;

PS-20230327-0590 Stirling, Yard broken into and diesel stolen from vehicle and fuel tank.

PS-20230328-2247 Kirriemuir Theft of diesel froma JCB at a farm.

PS-20230329-1806 Perth 1000 litres of red diesel stolen from a fuel tank at a farm.

PS-20230331-4658 Glasgow Males seen on site and later found stolen fuel where they had ran off to.

PS-20230407-0906 Irvine 250 litres of fuel stolen from distribution depot.

PS-20230411-0539 Hawick £400 worth of fuel stolen from diggers and excavators at site.

PS-20230414-0518 Broxburn Fuel cap prised off and diesel syphoned from lorry.

PS-20230414-1119 Newport on Tay Diesel stolen from a 14t JCB at locus. small blue van in area recently.

PS-20230418-0926 Forfar Red diesel stolen from farm.

PS-20230418-1341 Dundee 1300 litres of red diesel stolen from farm.

half a tank of diesel stolen from his LGV whilst parked up overnight at the side of the A1. Reports another truck was targeted NFD).

Kilmarnock

Large quantity of white diesel stolen from tank.. Metal fence at rear of compound has been cut.

THEFTS AND DAMAGE TO PLANT AND MACHINERY

Theft and damage to plant and machinery can be particularly disruptive and expensive.

Below is details of an incident and where it happened along with the incident number.



PS-20230328-0927 Shotts 1 ton dumper stolen from site.

PS-20230331-0725 Moodiesburn Yellow Volvo mini digger stolen from site stolen from site.

PS-20230404-0714 Peterhead JCB telescopic plant stolen from site

PS-20230404-0376 Glasgow Digger spray painted whilst on site.

PS-20230410-0495 Glasgow 3 youths have broken into site and drove JCB about the site and damaged it



OTHER THEFTS AND CRIMES



Cable theft is a UK wide trend, please ensure that sufficient measures are in place to protect this asset.

The other crimes that have been reported in the last two weeks are as follows;

PS-20230328-3187 Motherwell Cable stolen by 3 suspects in a white transit van (nfd)

PS-20230329-0609 Newton Mearns Tools and other items stolen from site (nfd)

PS-20230329-2529 Glasgow Complainer was working on 5th floor and his power tools were stolen.

PS-20230330-1087 Glasgow Breaker digger attachment stolen from site. It would have required 3-4 people to move.

PS-20230330-3629 Glasgow Male seen stealing sheets of insulation, handing them over a fence to another.

PS-20230410-1725 East Calder House on construction site broken into at £7k worth of tools stolen.



PS-20230410-2647 Edinburgh Scaffolding boards stolen from site.

PS-20230412-0598 Aberdeen Large amount of tools stolen from construction site.

PS-20230414-0591 Saltcoats Containers broken into/damaged and pipes, copper and a quantity of diesel has been stolen from site.

PS-20230414-1029 Ayr Male entered secured yard of distribution depot and thereafter accessed various containers and vehicles and item stolen (nfd).

PS-20230414-1920 Paisley 12 solar panels stolen from site.

PS-20230410-0696 Stirling Youths broke into site and damage inflicted on partially constructed houses.

PS-20230412-1322 Glasgow Roller, trailer, rammer, Stihl saw, 12 inch vibrating plate and 16 inch vibrating plate have been stolen.
